Online Scams

Given the number of reported online scams recently, the Baringa IT team wanted to provide our school community with some scam information and helpful hints.

Talking about scams may help others identify a scam, raise awareness about the impacts of scams and help prevent people falling victim to scams.

Scams come in various forms. Some common types of scams are listed below:

- Unexpected winnings scams
- Buying or selling scams
- Attempts to gain personal information scams

Three helpful tips to avoid falling victim to a scam are:

- If it seems too good to be true, then it is!
- Avoid clicking on links that are emailed or text to you. Instead go directly to their website and check if the information is accurate there.

Avoid giving out your personal details, especially if you are unsure about the source of the text or email OR if the person requesting the information is unknown to you.




Bus Awards

The cave was my favorite part of camp! - Tyrell









MEASUREMENT



Students of SLC1 are on the topic of measurement in their numeracy class. They are using rulers and other measuring tools to understand the concept of using CM (centimetres) and MM (millimetres). The students are using practical examples of measuring, these include measuring different sized objects in the classroom and measuring the height of all the students in the class. They use the results to order who is the tallest and shortest in the class. The teacher is the shortest.
