This week we are encouraging our families to read our Headlice Policy.



# HOW TO GET RID OF LICE ON LAUNDRY

from 



Clean every item that you came in contact with 2 days prior to first treatment.



Wash in hot water & dry at a high temperature for 20 minutes.



For non-washable items, store in garbage bag for 1 week.



To quickly remove lice, place item in freezer.

1 USE A PROVEN TREATMENT AND FOLLOW ALL DIRECTIONS

2 WHEN TREATING HEAD LICE, START AT THE NAPE OF THE NECK AND BEHIND THE EARS

3 CHECK FOR NITS (HEAD LICE EGGS) AND USE A NIT COMB TO REMOVE THEM

6 DRY CLEAN ITEMS THAT CANNOT BE WASHED




# S8
