We'd also like to remind families that **next Friday, August 1st, is a Student-Free Day.** There will be no school programs running, so students are required to stay home.

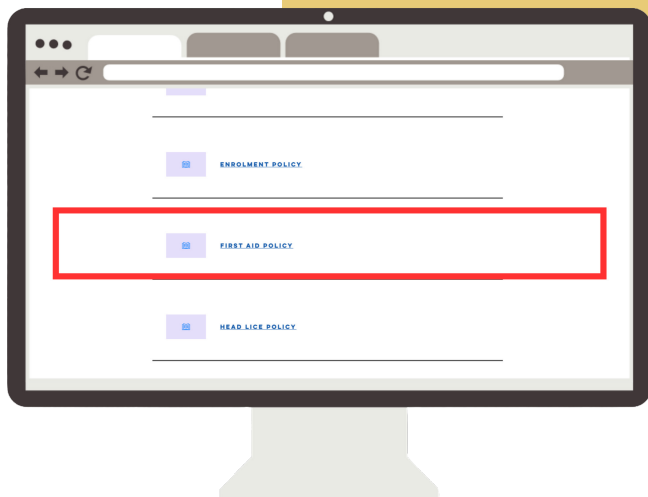

School Policy

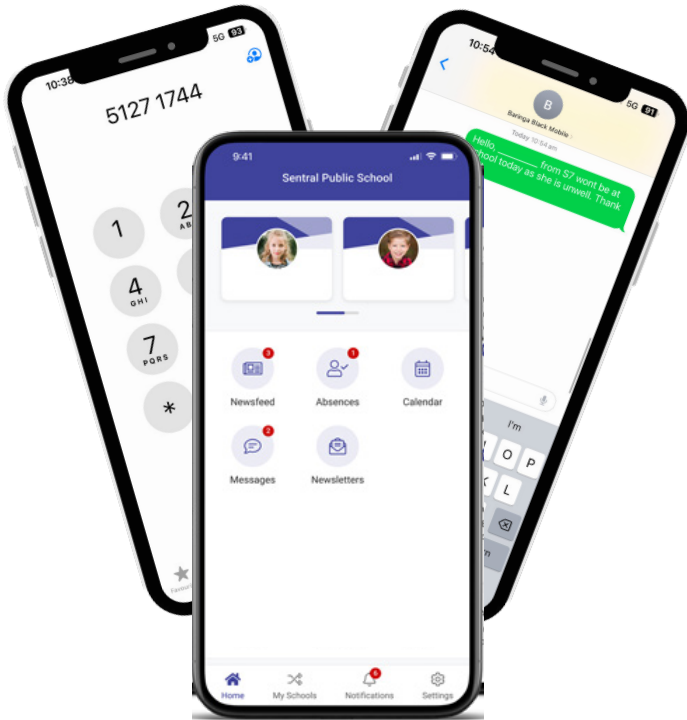
First Aid Policy

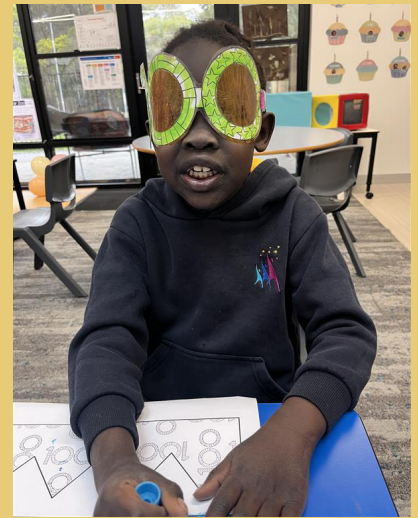
NAIDOC Week
